Special Joint Session: Resilience, Business Continuity, and Risk Management: What Treasurers Should Know **Regeneron Headquarters, 1 Rockwood Road Sleepy Hollow, New York 10591**

The Life Sciences members are invited to join the last session of NeuGroup's MegaCap Treasurers meeting, also happening at Regeneron. Treasurers have come to expect market volatility and business disruptions as the "new normal." Many companies now have "crisis teams" and "crisis playbooks" based on experience during the Great Financial Crisis, the COVID pandemic, and several geopolitical conflicts. Even so, resilience, business continuity, and risk management now face a new threat posed by bad actors using AI to penetrate corporate infrastructure.

In this session, members will hear from Mark Harvey, Senior Director of Business Resilience at Regeneron. At Regeneron, Mark leads global, cross-functional efforts to anticipate and adapt to potential disruptions to operations, finances, reputation, and compliance. He also provides strategy, operations, and oversight to integrate business continuity and crisis management capabilities and ensure they align with holistic risk management efforts.

Mark is a highly respected and collaborative leader experienced in relationship management and organizational change across complex, global organizations, including the National Security Council, the Department of Homeland Security, the Intelligence Community, and the financial services industry.

Member Spotlight: The Regeneron Genetics Center

We continue our tradition of learning about members with a look at the Regeneron Genetics Center (RGC), the genomics research arm of Regeneron Pharma.

RGC is focused on large-scale human genetics research to drive drug discovery and development. It's known for building one of the largest genetic and clinical datasets in the world, sequencing hundreds of thousands (now well over 3 million) of participants' exomes/genomes and linking that data with electronic health records to identify disease-associated gene variants. This work helps validate and prioritize drug targets earlier in the development pipeline by connecting genetic mutations to human health outcomes at population scale.

We'll learn about the origins and history of the RGC, as well as the underlying principles that guide the work of this world leading genetics discovery engine.
