



How legal teams can use Codex

Use Codex to turn redlines, signed agreements, deal notes, and policies into a counsel-ready review note.

Why Codex for legal

Legal teams are often asked to explain what changed and what needs a decision, fast. Redlines, signed agreements, deal notes, policy docs, and playbooks all matter. Codex can organize the evidence, cite the source material, and prepare a review note counsel can inspect.

Sample prompt set for an agreement review

Use the Acme redline, last signed Acme MSA, Salesforce notes, Agreements Playbook, retention exception request, and Privacy policy. Do not give legal advice. Compare the drafts and show material changes with clause references for counsel.

Explain the five most important Acme changes in plain English for the account lead.

Draft a note with the issue, next step, and clauses counsel should review.

Check the Acme retention exception request against the Privacy policy.

Prepare an Acme legal review note with decisions, source links, and next actions.

Turn approved Acme fallback language into a review checklist for the account team.
